Keynote Speaker



Tanya D. Marsh, Professor of Law, Wake Forest University

The fascinating law of cemeteries in the United States is grounded

in Roman law and English Church law, but was largely invented in the mid-19th century by a New York real estate developer and attorney named Samuel B. Ruggles.

This session will focus on recent court cases in New York State, as well as legal trends in other states that may impact New York.

Tanya D. Marsh is a Professor of Law at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. A graduate of Indiana University and Harvard Law School, Tanya is a licensed attorney in Indiana and a licensed funeral director in California. Tanya developed and teaches the first (and only) law school course on funeral and cemetery law. She is the author of the first treatise in the area since 1950—The Law of Human Remains (2015) and coauthor of the only casebook, Cemetery Law: The Common Law of Burying Places (2015). An Associate Reporter for the Restatement (Fourth) of Property, Tanya has been elected to the American College of Real Estate Lawyers. See back cover for book information.

The Board approved changes to the By-Laws that were recommended by the By-Laws Committee. Full text of the new By-Laws will be available to membership in the Broadcaster.

Pursuant to the By-Laws, these changes will be submitted for approval of the Members at the Annual Members Meeting to be held on Monday, September 19, 2016. The revised By-Laws would eliminate the First Vice-President and Second Vice-President position as officers, substituting it with "one or more Vice Presidents" in Article VII, section 1.
